Fee and Funding Structure



15 hours

The term after your child's third birthday they will be eligible for 15 hours of government-funded childcare over the year (570 hours).

30 hours

If eligible, your child will be allowed 1,140 hours of government-funded childcare.

- You can apply from when your child is 2 years and 9 months old.
- You have to reconfirm your eligibility every 3 months. If you apply more than 3 months before the term starts, you'll have to reconfirm your eligibility in your account in order to keep your code valid.

- You can apply outside of these recommended dates, but you might not receive your code in time.
- You must have a valid code by the end of the month before a new term starts.

Contract 51 weeks: 15 hours or 30 funded hours

An all year-round contract, covering the 51 weeks the nursery is open. (Closed for a week at Christmas.) The funding will be stretched over 51 weeks of the year, which equates to 11 (or 22 hours per week, if eligible for 30 hours).
